Two-Week Capacity Building Programme for Social Sciences Faculty Members and Research Scholars

(Date: 20th June to 2nd July 2022)

Concept Note

The GIDS, Lucknow proposes to organize capacity building programme for young researchers and junior faculties in various social science disciplines. ‘Capacity building’ is a process that progresses knowledge, skills, understanding, systems and institutions of people within a given socio-cultural setup, and whereby people and organizations of a society systematically stimulate and develop their capabilities over the time to achieve a particular set of social, cultural and economic goals. While considering the potentials, limits and requirements, the capability building programme for faculties and research scholars in social sciences, especially for those who teach and research in academic institutions located in rural areas or in relative isolation, has been conceptualized as a fundamental tool to resolve problems related to quality research and teaching, policy formulation, institution building and so on.

A central goal of the Capacity Building Programme (CBP) is to promote and emphasize on the usages of scientific tools and techniques by the faculty members, post-doctoral and doctoral researchers for conducting high quality research. Young participants will be able to establish their foothold in the academia, to get a hold of high quality academic standards, to have a hands-on experience and illuminations on ‘how to formulate different academic writings and get them published in the refereed journals or with reputed publishers’.

The Objective of the Course

The core objective of the programme is to enable young faculties to conduct their research work in a scientific and systematic manner, and to select and make use of suitable research methods; to use appropriate research tools and to analyze their research questions with appropriate analysis of data in their research and to turn their completed research into published materials in the form of books and articles in academic journals.

Specifically, the objectives are as follows:

- To develop capacity for conceptualising and writing research proposals;
- To enhance skills to prepare an appropriate research design, including conducting and overview of literature, formulating research questions and hypothesis, collection of information and analysis;
- To upgrade the skill of using software used in social science research;

- To enhance the capacity for writing research paper/book for publications;;
- To develop the capacity for research grant applications; and
- To guide participants for collaborative and multi- disciplinary research in the areas of social science and allied disciplines.

Overview of the course module

- a. Introduction to Social Science Research: Idea of research-nature, scope and theories; basic tenets of qualitative and quantitative research.
- b. Fundamentals of Social Research (Theoretical framework, Conceptual Framework- concepts and measureable variables)
- c. Quantitative Research Methods (Methods and their Nuances-Social survey)
- d. Qualitative Research Methods (Methods and their Nuances- ethnography, case study, content analysis, FGDs Observation)
- e. Methodological and Measurement Issues in Social Science Research.
- f. Triangulation and Hybrid Methods.
- g. Developing Research Proposal.
- h. Formulation of Problem in Social Research.
- i. Research Design: Selection of topics for research; factors influencing problems in selection; pure versus applied research; literature review; theorization and contextualization of the topic under consideration, objective, research questions., analysis, and types research design with suitable examples.
- j. Survey Method and Sampling, and Basic Quantitative Analysis: Data and data sources; secondary data sources- limitations; primary data- collection of primary data, concept of survey, construction of questionnaire, open and closed responses, mailed questionnaire, factor affecting mail surveys; sampling techniques; and statistical techniques.
- k. Hypothesis Concept & Types of Hypotheses, formulation and testing.
- l. Designing and formulation of questionnaire and Interview schedule.
- m. Online data searching and use of Internet
- n. Descriptive Statistics: Measurement of Central Tendency, Dispersion, Regression and Correlation
- o. Analysis of Quantitative Data: advanced quantitative techniques: multivariate regression analyses; limited/qualitative variables and models involving these variables: usages of slope and intercept dummy; linear probability, logit and probit models; basic panel data models.
- p. Data Processing: STATA and SPSS.
- q. Ethics in Academic Writings; Ethics and the researchers, ethics and the scientific community, ethics and sponsors of research; ethical issues involving human subjects- harm, deception, informed consent, special populations and new inequalities; privacy, anonymity, and

confidentiality, making ethical decisions; meaning and seriousness of plagiarism; different types of plagiarism; how to prevent plagiarism in research; the politics of research: limits on research and dissemination of research findings.

- r. Academic Writing: Meaning and types of academic writing; challenges in Academic Writing; papers for academic journals; preparations of reports; how writing books is different from writing a PhD thesis.
- s. Structure: Structure of a research paper, report or book; differences in structure of each kind of writing.
- t. Application of Research Findings
- u. Publication Process: Journals- submission, review process, revision; Books- manuscript presentation, review, editing, dealing with a rejection, significance of revision; criteria for selection.

DurationoftheCourse:

The proposed Capacity Building Programme is planned to be organized during 20th June to 2nd July, 2022.

Number ofParticipants Applied:

A total of Thirty (30) participants would be admitted in the programme which will include 10 from the city, 10 from the U.P. state and 10 from outside of U.P.

Accommodation and Travel Cost:

The stay arrangement for all participants will be made free in the guest house/hostel of the Institute along with complete hospitality. The participants from within (10) and outside of U.P. State (10) will be provided AC-III/ Bus/fare as per provisions of the ICSSR.
